

# Do you know the symptoms of cervical cancer?

The most common symptoms include:



Vaginal bleeding that is unusual  
for you – after menopause,  
between regular periods  
or after sex



Unexplained pain in your lower back  
or between your hip bones (pelvis)



Pain or discomfort during sex



Changes to vaginal discharge

These symptoms are not usually cervical cancer, but it's  
important to get them checked out.

Don't wait for cervical screening (a smear test)

Speak to your GP or practice nurse if you are  
worried about your symptoms
